6. PERFORMANCES: No dancer may engage in any dance performances, dance demonstrations, or other type theatrical performances which would create a conflict with the ballet company without permission of the Artistic Director and the Executive Board.	
7. EQUIPMENT: Dancers are expected to furnish their own leotards, tights, shoes, and personal dance equipment for classes, rehearsals, and performances. Appropriate costumes and necessary additional dance wear will be furnished as needed for performances. Such costumes and equipment remain the property of the company and the dancer is expected to observe the rules established by the Company Manager in caring for the wardrobe and equipment. When one costume becomes unwearable it means the whole group has to be replaced, you will be charged accordingly if this is to happen through your negligence.	
8. FOOD:	No food, alcohol, tobacco, or drug products are allowed in the studios.
